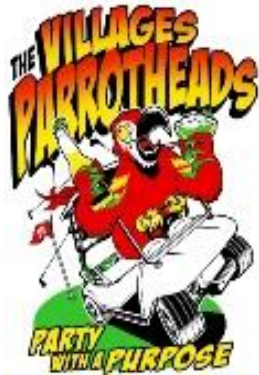


Inaugural Leesburg TropRock Music Festival...
