

Parrot Heads, we have some new and exciting news! We are going to begin using an automated

system for checking into phlockings! Beginning July 3rd at our Cane Garden phlocking, you will receive a QR Code sticker to attach to your Parrothead ID.

Our Vision is to have the greeters scan your QR Code as you arrive - easypeasy! This will prevent waiting in lines, make it easier on the greeters, and streamline the process for those analyzing the data for reporting purposes.

Bonnie Menard is leading the development and rollout of this capability. The July phlockings will begin the distribution for the QR Code stickers with plans to go live in September.

While we are currently only using this new system for phlocking attendance, it will be further developed to use at many other events! This will make everything that is currently done manually so much easier and faster, and we are very excited about this new technology for our club!

There is nothing further you need to do, just get your QR Code sticker when you check into your next phlocking!






